
# **Podcasting Main Techniques**

Good Introductions	Be spontaneous, conversational and less scripted
Informality	Be warm and engage the listener on a one-to-one basis
Personal	Effective starter ideas: ask a question that listeners might want the answer to or an immediate dive into the story you're telling.
Audio	Make your podcast sound like a podcast by:  • Speaking directly to listeners and be informal  • Introducing yourself to your listeners  • Using music to signpost how the listener should be feeling
