E 2.3 Influence of organisations and individuals on health issues



For your Unit 2 exam you will be given an information booklet to read and use for section B of the exam. In the information booklet, there will be an article where information will be presented by different organisations and individuals. You need to be able to discuss how organisations and/or individuals affect the following of the article:

- **Validity** and **reliability** of **quantitative** and **qualitative** data sources and the conclusions presented in the article; and
- **Influence** on the health issue presented in the article

Task 1

Research the organisations below and answer the following about each one:

- Overview of who they are
- What area of health/science are they specialists in
- What type of organisation are they:
 - Global organisation
 - Part of UK government
 - Charity
 - University
 - private or multinational organisations
 - pharmaceutical companies
 - Another non-government organisation (NGO)
- How **reliable** are their statements? Are their decisions based on opinion or scientific research?
- Would they have a vested interest/be biased?
- Who do they **influence**?
 - Global decisions
 - National decisions e.g. consult on policy in the UK government
 - Provides research that can be used to improve health
 - Diagnose and/or treat illnesses
 - Provides information/opinion to the public
